A meeting of the Parochial Electors of the Parish of Begbroke, convened by the following Parochial Electors, viz: Messrs. W. H. Freeman, Chas. Everson, George Gough, Henry Hawkes, Willem. Winch and Frank Hutt, was held at the Royal Sun Inn, Begbroke, on Thursday May 17, 1906, at 6 o'clock in the evening. There were present Messrs. W. H. Freeman, Henry Hawkes, & Mr. Winch. ^{Mr. Freeman was unanimously elected Chairman of the meeting.} The business was to consider an application from the Assistant Overseer for an increase of salary.

Mr. C. J. Martin the Assistant Overseer attended & explained that his present salary was £3 per annum. He asked for an increase of £2 per annum.

Mr. Freeman proposed that the old appointment of the Assistant Overseer be revoked & that Mr. C. J. Martin be reappointed Assistant Overseer at a salary of £5 per annum to be paid in halfyearly payments of £2.10/- the first halfyearly payment to be made on Sept. 29th next.

Mr. Winch seconded.
