

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(A4260 KIDLINGTON TO ADDERBURY) (50 & 60 MPH SPEED LIMITS)
ORDER 20****

Oxfordshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (A4260 Kidlington to Adderbury) (50 & 60 mph Speed Limits) Order 20** and shall come into force on the day of 20**.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 60 miles per hour in the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
5. The Oxfordshire County Council (A4260 Kidlington to Bunkers Hill) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2001 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE 1

50mph speed limit:

A4260

1. Within the parishes of Kidlington, Shipton-on-Cherwell & Thrupp, and Tackley:

a)	from a point 80 metres northwest of its junction with Langford Lane, north-westwards	to a point 105 metres southeast of its junction with the A4095 Upper Campsfield Road
b)	from a point 250 metres northwest of its junction with the A4095 Bunkers Hill, north-westwards	to a point 340 metres north of its junction with the unnamed road from 'Sturdys Castle' to Tackley

2. Within the parishes of Tackley, Rousham, Steeple Barton, and Steeple Aston:

b)	from a point 120 metres south of its junction with the unnamed road to Rousham, northwards	to a point 250 metres south of its junction with the B4030 to Middle Barton.
c)	from a point 220 metres north of its junction with the B4030 to Middle Barton, northwards	to a point 145 metres south of its junction with the unnamed road to Middle Aston Lane

3. Within the parishes of Middle Aston, North Aston, Duns Tew, and Deddington:

d)	from a point 80 metres south of the access to the Thames Water reservoir site, northwards	to a point 24 metres southeast of its junction with Chapmans Lane
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4. Within the parishes of Deddington, and Adderbury:

e)	from a point 121 metres north of its junction with The Leyes, northwards	to a point 182 metres south of its junction with Berry Hill Road
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SCHEDULE 2

60mph speed limit:

Within the parishes of Middle Aston, and Steeple Aston:

a)	A4260 Northbound carriageway only	from a point 145 metres south of its junction with the unnamed road to Middle Aston Lane, northwards	a point 80 metres south of the access to the Thames Water reservoir site
