

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(STEEPLE ASTON PARISH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20****

Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Steeple Aston Parish) (20 mph Speed Limit) Order 20** and shall come into force on the day of 20**.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in Schedule **1** of this Order.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
5. The Oxfordshire County Council (Steeple Aston Parish) (Speed Limit) Order 2024 is hereby revoked/replaced.

SCHEDULE 1

20mph speed limit:

The whole length of every road in the village of Steeple Aston extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

a)	Fenway	a point 55 metres west of its junction with Coneygar Fields
b)	Fir Lane	a point 325 metres north of its junction with North Side
c)	Heyford Road	a point 200 metres south of its junction with the southern leg of The Crescent.
d)	South Side	a point 196 metres west of its junction with Water Lane.

SCHEDULE 2

40mph speed limit:

a)	A4095 Oxford Road	from its junction with the B4030 (to Middle Barton), northwards	for a distance of 220 metres.
b)	B4030 (to Lower Heyford)	from its junction with the A4095 Oxford Road, eastwards	for a distance of 215 metres.
