

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(STEEPLE BARTON & WESTCOT BARTON PARISHES) (SPEED LIMITS)
ORDER 20****

Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Steeple Barton & Westcot Barton Parishes) (Speed Limits) Order 20** and shall come into force on the day of 20**.
2. No person shall drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour in any of the roads specified in Schedule 1 to this order.
3. No person shall drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour in any of the roads specified in Schedule 2 to this order.
4. No person shall drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour in any of the roads specified in Schedule 3 to this order.
5. No person shall drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of 50 miles per hour in any of the roads specified in Schedule 4 to this order.
6. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
7. The Oxfordshire County (Steeple Barton & Westcot Barton Parishes) (Speed Limits) Order 2023 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE 1

20mph speed limit:

The whole length of every road in the villages of Steeple Barton and Westcot Barton extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the villages) to the following points:

a)	B4030 Enstone Road	a point 285 metres southwest of its junction with the unnamed road to Sandford St Martin.
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b)	B4030 North Street	a point 140 metres northeast of its junction with Holliers Crescent.
c)	Church Lane	a point 575 metres east of its junction with Mill Lane
d)	Kiddington Road	a point 330 metres south of its junction with South Street
e)	Worton Road	a point 122 metres north of its junction with Hillside Road
f)	Sandford St Martin Road	a point 308 metres northwest of its junction with the B4030 Enstone Road.

SCHEDULE 2

30mph speed limit:

a)	B4030 Enstone/Middle Barton Road	from a point 285 metres southwest of its junction with Sandford St Martin Road, south-westwards	to a point 405 metres east of its junction with Laundry Lane, at the Sandford St Martin parish boundary
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SCHEDULE 3

40mph speed limit:

	A4095 Banbury Road	from its junction with the B4030 (to Middle Barton), southwards	for a distance of 250 metres.
a)	B4030 North Street	from a point 140 metres northeast of its junction with Holliers Crescent, eastwards	to a point 55 metres east of its junction with Duns Tew Road.
	B4030 (to Middle Barton)	from its junction with the A4095 Banbury Road, westwards	for a distance of 80 metres.
b)	Duns Tew Road	from its junction with the B4030 North Street, north-eastwards	for a distance of 105 metres.

SCHEDULE 4

50mph speed limit:

B4030 Enstone/Middle Barton Road

a)	from its junction with Laundry Lane, at the Sandford St Martin parish boundary, eastwards	for a distance of 405 metres
b)	from a point 55 metres east of its junction with Duns Tew Road, south-eastwards	to its junction with the A4260 at Hopcrofts Holt.
