

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(KIDLINGTON AND GOSFORD & WATER EATON) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20****

Oxfordshire County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Kidlington and Gosford & Water Eaton) (Speed Limits) Order 20** and shall come into force on the day of 20**
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
4. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
5. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 50 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 to this Order
6. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
7. The Oxfordshire County Council (Kidlington and Gosford & Water Eaton) (Speed Limits) Order 2024 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE 1

20mph Speed Limit:

The whole length of every road in Kidlington and Gosford & Water Eaton, including the A4260 service roads (and excluding those lengths of road listed in Schedules 2 & 3) extending in the case of the respective roads leading out of those Parishes and/or joining speeds of a higher limit to the following points:

a)	Bicester Road, Kidlington	to a point 66 metres west of its junction with the Bicester Road (C43)
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b)	Water Eaton Lane	to its junction with the Bicester Road (C43)
c)	Yarnton Road	to a point 27 metres southwest of its junction with Newport Close
d)	A4260 Banbury Road	a point 25 metres north of its junction with Benmead Road
e)	A4260 Oxford Road	a point 25 metres southeast of its junction with Yarnton Road

SCHEDULE 2

30mph speed limit:

a)	A4260 Banbury Road	from a point 25 metres north of its junction with Benmead Road, north-westwards	to a point 75 metres northwest of its junction with Langford Lane
b)	A4260 Oxford Road	from a point 25 metres southeast of its junction with Yarnton Road, south-eastwards	to the Kidlington roundabout and including its circulatory lanes
c)	Langford Lane	from its junction with the A4260 Banbury Road, westwards	to a point 42 50 metres west east of its junction with the western-most leg of Evenlode Crescent southbound carriageway of the A44 Woodstock Road
d)	A4165 Oxford/Banbury Road	from its junction with the Kidlington roundabout, southwards	to the Gosford Parish / Oxford City boundary, a point 187 metres north of its junction with Haslemere Gardens
e)	A4260 Frieze Way	from its junction with the Kidlington roundabout, south-westwards	for a distance of 250m metres
f)	Bicester Road (C43 Gosford & Water Eaton)	from its junction with the Kidlington roundabout, north-eastwards	for a distance of 352 metres
g)	Stratfield Brake access road entry slip	from its junction with the A4260 Frieze Way, westwards	for a distance of 34 metres
h)	Stratfield Brake access road exit slip	from its junction with the A4260 Frieze Way, westwards	for a distance of 25 metres

SCHEDULE 3

40mph speed limit:

a)	Bicester Road, Kidlington	From its junction with the Bicester Road (C43) Gosford & Water Eaton, westwards	for a distance of 66 metres.
b)	Bicester Road (C43), Gosford & Water Eaton	From a point 352 metres northeast of its junction with the Kidlington roundabout, north-eastwards	to a point 535 metres northeast of its junction with Bicester Road, Kidlington.

SCHEDULE 4

50mph speed limit:

a)	Langford Lane	From its junction with the A44 Woodstock Road southbound carriageway, eastwards	for a distance of 50 metres.
